

PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENT

Statement by the City of College Park, Georgia Regarding Dismissal of City Manager

The College Park Mayor and City Council, at their regularly scheduled meeting on May 19, 2025, deliberated and ultimately terminated the current City Manager, Dr. Emmanuel Adediran from his position of City Manager.

Dr. Adediran had been promoted from Interim City Manager to City Manager eight months ago, and Dr. Adediran originally came to the city as Public Works Director.

The termination was decided by a vote of two in favor and two against on the City Council, with the tie broken by College Park Mayor Bianca Motley Broom. There will be no further public comment regarding the personnel matter at this time.

By city charter, the City Manager oversees all offices, agencies and departments within the municipal government, including hiring/firing city employees and the oversight of vendor contracts and purchasing, as well as the implementation and management of the annual city budget.

Ms. Lindell Miller, formerly a Procurement Officer with the City of College Park, will serve as Interim City Manager. City Hall and department office hours and services all will continue as usual.
